

Collecting and Using Personal Information

Welcome to CPC of America Inc.'s (CPC) Web site (site). We appreciate your interest and are dedicated to maintaining the privacy of your information. When you visit or navigate our site, we do not automatically collect personal information unless it is provided voluntarily by you via email.

CPC will not sell, license, transmit or disclose and non-public personal information that you may provide outside of CPC and its affiliated companies unless (a) expressly authorized by you, (b) necessary to enable CPC contractors or agents to perform certain functions for us, or (c) required or permitted by law. In all cases, we will disclose the information consistent with applicable laws and regulations and we will require the recipient to protect the information and use it only for the purpose for which it was provided.

By "personal information," we mean data that is unique to an individual, such as a name, address, Social Security number, e-mail address, or telephone number.

Emailing Us

User Data; "Cookies" and "Tags"

You should also be aware that when you visit our Web site, we collect certain information that does not identify you personally, but provides us with "usage data" that helps us to analyze and improve the usefulness of the information we provide at these Web sites. Usage data we collect may include:

- Type of user agent (web browser) used
- Type of operating system
- Screen resolution
- Network location and IP address
 - Can include country, city, state, region, county, or any other geographic data
 - Hostname
 - Bandwidth (internet connection speed)
- Time of visit
- Pages visited
- Time spent on each page of the Web site
- Referring site statistics
 - The Web site (URI) the user came through in order to arrive at this Web site (example: clicking on a hyperlink from Yahoo.com that took the user to this Web site)
 - Search engine query used (example: typing in a phrase into a search engine like Google, and clicking on a link from that search engine)
